Subject: Emergency Housing Assistance (EHA)

Good Morning,

We now have a new CHIP activity called the Emergency Housing Assistance (EHA) program. Households with incomes at or below 80% of area median income are eligible for assistance. Households can be provided up to three consecutive months of rent or monthly payments occurring on or after March 1, 2020. Households shall be served on a first-come, first-serve basis. Households will need to complete the EHA application, provide documentation of income, provide documentation of need (past-due rent or mortgage payments), and documentation of job loss, laid off, or other hardship due to COVID-19. Currently, EHA is available in the following CHIP communities. Erie(excluding City of Sandusky), Huron, Sandusky, Seneca, Hancock, Lucas (excluding City of Toledo) and Lorain (Excluding City of Lorain and City of Elyria).
